SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

<u>Synopsis</u>: This bill appropriates \$1.45 million to the Public Education Department to contract for the development and implementation of a multi component digital platform for youth behavioral health prevention.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The operating impact is unknown as OBAE cannot estimate the burden on the Public Education Department's ability to procure and manage this project.

It is also unknown what fiscal impact the project, once implemented, would have on the schools themselves.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

OBAE launched the Statewide Education Network (SEN) in 2024, which connects participant schools and public libraries together to provide scalable, reliable, affordable, and secure internet, while maximizing federal E-rate funding. The SEN provides services of 100Gbps to participants, while many non-participant schools and libraries receive only 10Gbps due to funding constraints and binding multi-year contracts.

Public Schools that are not currently able to participate in the SEN may lack the broadband capacity to utilize a multi-component digital platform, which would limit student ability to access the prevention services developed under the project.

PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS

OBAE is in the process of addressing cybersecurity through the SEN. Once those protections are in place, it would be possible for the Central Services offered by the SEN to include this project.

TECHNICAL ISSUES

The advantage of telehealth services is that they are not restricted by location, which can ameliorate access to providers in New Mexico's current behavioral health care shortage.

However, this project limits the participation to behavioral health care providers who are licensed by the State of New Mexico.
