**SECTION III: NARRATIVE** 

**BILL SUMMARY** 

Synopsis:

SB 292 amends the Public Employees Retirement Act [NMSA 1978 10-11-8] to allow retired members to return to work as protective service worker without suspension of their pension benefits. The bill also defines protective service worker as a person who is an employee of the protective service division of the Children, Youth and Families Department.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Because the statute requires return to work members and their employers to pay contributions it may have a very small positive impact to the funding ratio of the State General fund. For the year ending June 30, 2024, the State General fund ratio is 56.10%. The bill is currently undergoing an actuarial analysis for its impact to the fund.

SB 292 should not have an impact to PERA's operating budget.
