BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

SB301 creates the court emergency property reserve fund and appropriates four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000) from the general fund to the reserve fund. The fund may be used to pay the costs of emergency or unforeseen repair, reconstruction or replacement of court-owned property and expenses. The fund may also be used to pay the costs of administering the fund.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Because the New Mexico Courts have their own facilities division, which will oversee the court emergency property reserve fund, SB301 will not have a fiscal or administrative impact on the General Services Department's Facilities Management Division.
