Moreover, regulating the sale and manufacture of firearms and accessories under this Act could help prevent these products from falling into the wrong hands (e.g., criminals, minors, or unlicensed individuals).

Many communities face challenges with gun violence, and manufacturers of firearms and accessories are often not held accountable for how their products are used or distributed. Proactive regulation, such as including firearms under the Unfair Practices Act pursuant to this bill, could prevent the misuse of products and reduce harm before it occurs.
