BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

Senate Bill 329 would create a new felony crime for individuals who solicitate or recruit a child into a criminal street gang. Solicitation or recruitment means solicits or recruits a child to actively participate in a criminal street gang with the intent that the child who was solicited or recruited promote, further, assist or participate in the commission of one or more of the criminal offenses, or threatens any person with physical violence with the intent to coerce or induce a child to actively participate in a criminal street gang.
