BILL SUMMARY

<u>Synopsis</u>: SB 345 revises licensure processes for teachers and instructional support providers. The bill allows applicants to use a teacher portfolio in place of the standardized teacher assessment for Level One Licensure. It also expands reciprocity for instructional support providers, permitting those licensed in other states to qualify for Level Two and Level Three Licensure in New Mexico if they meet certain criteria.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SB 345 is not expected to impose direct fiscal impact on DHSEM.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The bill primarily affects educational licensing policies under the purview of the Public Education Department and does not impact DHSEM's emergency preparedness, disaster response, or homeland security functions.
