SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: Senate Bill 365 (SB365) appropriates \$100 thousand from the general fund to the New Mexico Commission on the Status of Women (CSW) for commission activities.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$100 thousand contained in this bill is a nonrecurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY26 shall revert to the general fund.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The Commission on the Status of Women reports that the funding in this bill would support contractor assistance, office space, and expanding and using the CSW database. This bill designates how the \$100 thousand in this bill should be spent.

WHAT WILL BE THE CONSEQUENCES OF NOT ENACTING THIS BILL

Without this funding, the CSW will not be able to hire contract assistance in FY26. Additionally, the Commission will not have funding to rent office space to house its two employees. Finally, the CSW will not be able to grow and use its database to reach women around the state regarding resources available to them and programming in their regions.
