SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: Senate Bill 386 (SB386)

SB386 amends the Public-School Codes, Courses of Instruction, particularly §§22-13-31 and 31.1, NMSA 1978 which address protocols to follow when a youth athlete suffers a brain injury. SB386 would allow licensed chiropractic physicians to be considered a "licensed healthcare professional" within the meaning of the statute. Currently, the meaning of "licensed healthcare professional" within the statutes applies to the following licensed, practicing professionals: a physician or physician assistant, an osteopathic physician or osteopathic physician assistant, a certified nurse practitioner, a psychologist, an athletic trainer, or a physical therapist.

By amending the definition of "licensed healthcare professional" to include chiropractic physicians, SB386 would allow chiropractic physicians to provide a medical release to a youth athlete after they have been diagnosed with or exhibits the signs symptoms or behaviors consistent with a brain injury.

The effective date of the legislation is June 20, 2025.
