Creates the local Government Border Support Reimbursement Fund to be administered by the Department of Finance and Administration to reimburse local governments for expenses related to emergency medical services, law enforcement response to “unattended deaths,” costs associated with supporting federal border patrol efforts and “humanitarian efforts” along the border, which include illegal dumping, state and federal drug trafficking task forces, and state and federal human trafficking task forces.
