BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

This bill amends NMSA 1978, Section 13-1-154.1 to raise the aggregate limits of certain contracts, and limits for certain individual contracts, that agencies may enter into. The amendment to paragraph A raises the limit of a single architectural or engineering contract from \$650,000 to \$2,000,000. The amendments to paragraph B change limits from one construction contract and all renewals to all construction contracts and all renewals and from \$12,500,000 over three years to \$30,000,000 over 10 years. The amendments to paragraph D change the limits over four years for existing contracts for architectural or engineering contracts from \$7,500,000 to \$15,000,000; and the limits for construction from \$12,500,000 over three years to \$30,000,000 over 10 years.
