BILL SUMMARY

Senate Bill 427 (SB427) appropriates sixty million dollars (\$60,000,000) to the Health Care Authority (HCA) from the General Fund in FY26 through FY28 to create new physician residency programs and positions. Any unexpended funding reverts at the end of FY28.

The New Mexico Higher Education Department's (NMHED) analysis of this bill focuses on the higher education implications of the proposed legislation. Additional analysis should be obtained from other agencies.
