<u>Synopsis:</u> Senate Bill 457 will appropriate \$20,000,000 from the general fund to the civil legal services fund for the fiscal year 2026 and subsequent fiscal years to provide civil legal services to low-income persons. Any remaining unexpended or unencumbered balance at the end of the fiscal year will not revert to the general fund.
