SB 474 – Streamline Certain Adoption Processes adds a definition of "prenatal abandonment" as the failure of an acknowledged or alleged father to provide reasonable, safe and consistent support to the mother and child during pregnancy to the set of definitions of the Adoptions Act of the Children's Code. The bill outlines circumstances that constitute "prenatal abandonment" by an alleged father or acknowledged father during pregnancy. The bill expands the circumstances of the termination of parental rights to include "prenatal abandonment" of an acknowledged or alleged father.
