11 RELATING TO LIBRARIES; ENACTING THE LIBRARIAN PROTECTION ACT;  
12 PROSCRIBING THE BANNING OF LIBRARY MATERIALS.  
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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] SHORT TITLE.--This act may be  
16 cited as the "Librarian Protection Act".

17 SECTION 2. [NEW MATERIAL] DEFINITIONS.--As used in the  
18 Librarian Protection Act:

19 A. "ban" means the act of removing or prohibiting  
20 the addition of materials from a public library not in  
21 accordance with an established and approved collection  
22 development policy;

23 B. "challenge" means an attempt to remove or  
24 restrict materials from a public library; and

25 C. "public library" means a New Mexico organization

1 that offers basic library services that are available to the  
2 general public.

3 SECTION 3. [NEW MATERIAL] PUBLIC LIBRARIES--PROHIBITING  
4 BOOK BANNING.--

5 A. A public library shall not be eligible to  
6 receive state funds unless the library:

7 (1) adopts a written policy that complies with  
8 the American library association's library bill of rights, as  
9 adopted in 2019, including the requirement that library  
10 materials not be proscribed or removed because of partisan or  
11 doctrinal disapproval of the material's content or based on the  
12 author's race, nationality, gender identity, sexual orientation  
13 or political or religious views; or

14 (2) adopts a written policy prohibiting the  
15 practice of banning books or other library materials within the  
16 library or library system on the basis of partisan or doctrinal  
17 disapproval of the material's content or based on the author's  
18 race, nationality, gender identity, sexual orientation or  
19 political or religious views pursuant to rules promulgated by  
20 the state librarian.

21 B. A political subdivision of the state shall not  
22 reduce funding for a public library due to the library's  
23 compliance with the provisions of Subsection A of this section.

24 C. The provisions of Subsection A of this section  
25 are not intended to curtail the right of individuals to

1 challenge library materials as part of an approved library  
2 collection development policy following established library  
3 materials challenge procedures.

4 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the  
5 provisions of this act is July 1, 2025.

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
