15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. Section 61-17A-22 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993,
17 Chapter 171, Section 22, as amended) is amended to read:

18 "61-17A-22. EXEMPTIONS.--The following persons are exempt
19 from the provisions of the Barbers and Cosmetologists Act while
20 in the discharge of their professional duties:

21 A. persons licensed by the law of this state to
22 practice medicine and surgery or chiropractic;

23 B. commissioned medical or surgical officers of the
24 United States army, navy or marine hospital service;

25 C. registered nurses;
