11 RELATING TO ELECTIONS; DECLARING THE FIRST TUESDAY IN NOVEMBER  
12 AS "ELECTION DAY"; MAKING ELECTION DAY A PAID HOLIDAY FOR STATE  
13 AND OTHER PUBLIC EMPLOYEES; PROVIDING EXEMPTIONS.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 SECTION 1. Section 1-12-42 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969,  
17 Chapter 240, Section 302, as amended) is amended to read:

18 "1-12-42. CONDUCT OF ELECTION--EMPLOYEES--[TIME] DAY TO  
19 VOTE.--

20 A. On election day a voter may be absent [~~himself~~]  
21 from employment [~~in which he is engaged for two hours for the~~  
22 ~~purpose of voting~~] between the time of opening and the time of  
23 closing the polls. The voter shall not be liable to any  
24 penalty for such absence, [~~however, the employer may specify~~  
25 ~~the hours during this period in which the voter may be absent~~]

1 and the state and other public employers shall provide the full  
2 day's compensation to the voter.

3 B. The provisions of Subsection A of this section  
4 do not apply to ~~[an employee whose work day begins more than~~  
5 ~~two hours subsequent to the time of opening the polls, or ends~~  
6 ~~more than three hours prior to the time of closing the polls]~~  
7 employees necessary to supervise and administer elections on  
8 election day, including employees of the secretary of state,  
9 local governments, Indian nations, tribes or pueblos or law  
10 enforcement.

11 C. The provisions of Subsection A of this section  
12 apply to elections of Indian nations, tribes or pueblos for a  
13 voter who is enrolled as a member of the Indian nation, tribe  
14 or pueblo and is qualified to vote in the election.

15 D. A person who refuses the right granted in this  
16 section to an employee is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be  
17 punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor  
18 more than one hundred dollars (\$100)."

19 SECTION 2. Section 12-5-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969,  
20 Chapter 114, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

21 "12-5-2. LEGAL HOLIDAYS--DESIGNATION.--Legal public  
22 holidays in New Mexico are:

- 23 A. New Year's day, January 1;
- 24 B. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday, third Monday
- 25 in January;

- 13 ~~[J.]~~ K. Christmas day, December 25."
