12	CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO PROVIDE THAT EACH REGULAR SESSION
13	OF THE LEGISLATURE SHALL NOT EXCEED FORTY-FIVE DAYS, REMOVE THE
14	RESTRICTIONS ON BILLS THAT MAY BE CONSIDERED IN EVEN-NUMBERED
15	YEARS AND PROVIDE FOR CONSIDERATION OF VETO OVERRIDES FOR BILLS
16	OF A REGULAR, SPECIAL OR EXTRAORDINARY LEGISLATIVE SESSION
17	WITHIN THE SAME BIENNIUM.

19	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
20	SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 5
21	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:
22	"A. Each regular session of the legislature shall
23	begin annually at 12:00 noon on the third Tuesday of January.
24	Every regular session of the legislature [convening during an
25	odd-numbered year shall remain in session not to exceed sixty

1 days, and every regular session of the legislature convening 2 during an even-numbered year] shall remain in session not to exceed [thirty] forty-five days. No special session of the 3 4 legislature shall exceed thirty days. Every regular session of the legislature 5 Β. [convening during an even-numbered year shall consider only the 6 7 following: 8 (1) budgets, appropriations and revenue bills; (2) bills drawn pursuant to special messages 9 10 of the governor; and (3)] may consider for veto override bills of 11 12 [the last previous] a regular, [session vetoed by the governor] 13 special or extraordinary session within the same legislative 14 biennium." 15 The amendment proposed by this resolution SECTION 2. 16 shall be submitted to the people for their approval or 17 rejection at the next general election or at any special 18 election prior to that date that may be called for that 19 purpose. 20 - 2 -21 22 23 24 25 .229263.1
