10 A JOINT RESOLUTION

11 PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 4 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW
12 MEXICO TO PROVIDE THAT A DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY
13 PURSUANT TO A POWER GRANTED TO THE GOVERNOR BY LAW, AND ORDERS
14 ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THAT DECLARATION, SHALL TERMINATE
15 WITHIN NINETY DAYS AND NOT BE RE-DECLARED UNLESS THE
16 DECLARATION OF THE STATE OF EMERGENCY IS EXTENDED, MODIFIED OR
17 TERMINATED BY A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE LEGISLATURE ON AN
18 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF THREE-FIFTHS OF EACH HOUSE OF THE
19 LEGISLATURE.

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

22 SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4 of the
23 constitution of New Mexico by adding a new section to read:

24 "A. A declaration of a state of emergency issued by
25 the governor pursuant to a gubernatorial power granted to the

1 governor in law, and orders issued in accordance with that
2 declaration, shall terminate at the end of ninety days unless
3 that declaration is extended, modified or terminated by a joint
4 resolution of the legislature on an affirmative vote of three-
5 fifths of the members elected to each house of the legislature.

6 B. A joint resolution may extend, modify or
7 terminate a gubernatorial declaration of a state of emergency
8 and any order issued in accordance with that declaration. The
9 gubernatorial declaration shall cease to be in effect on the
10 termination date specified in the joint resolution, which shall
11 be no later than ninety days after the passage of the joint
12 resolution. The legislature may pass other joint resolutions
13 for further ninety-day periods in a special session called for
14 that purpose, in extraordinary session or in a regular session,
15 if one occurs during a declared emergency.

16 C. During a state of emergency declared by the
17 governor, if the legislature is not called into special session
18 by the governor, the legislature may call itself into
19 extraordinary session in accordance with Article 4, Section 6
20 of the constitution of New Mexico to extend, modify or
21 terminate the gubernatorial declaration as provided in this
22 section."

23 SECTION 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution
24 shall be submitted to the people for their approval or
25 rejection at the next general election or at any special
