AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; DELAYING THE MANDATORY EMPLOYMENT OF  
SCHOOL NURSES UNTIL JULY 1, 1997.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-8-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,  
Chapter 16, Section 63, as amended by Laws 1993, Chapter 226,  
Section 19) is amended to read:

"22-8-9. BUDGETS-- MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS. --

A. No budget for a school district shall be approved  
by the department that does not provide for:

(1) a school year consisting of at least one  
hundred eighty full instructional days or the equivalent  
thereof, exclusive of any release time for in-service training;

or

(2) a variable school year consisting of a

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1 minimum number of instructional hours established by the state  
2 board; and

3 (3) a pupil-teacher ratio or class or teaching  
4 load as provided in Section 22-2-8.2 NMSA 1978; and

5 (4) effective July 1, 1997, a full-time,  
6 department-certified nurse for each fifty-five teachers employed  
7 by a school district or the equivalent part-time, department-  
8 certified nurse for less than fifty-five teachers.

9 B. The state board shall, by regulation, establish  
10 the requirements for a teaching day, the standards for an  
11 instructional hour and the standards for a full-time certified  
12 classroom instructor and for the equivalent thereof.

13 C. The local school board shall submit a plan for  
14 the implementation of an alternate school year to the state  
15 superintendent for his approval.

16 D. The provisions of Subsection C and Paragraph (2)  
17 of Subsection A of this section shall be construed to apply only  
18 to school districts with a MEM of [~~1,000~~] one thousand or  
19 fewer. "

20 Section 2. REPEAL. -- That version of Section 22-8-9 NMSA  
21 1978 (being Laws 1967, Chapter 16, Section 63, as amended) that  
22 is to become effective July 1, 1995 pursuant to Laws 1993,  
23 Chapter 223, Section 1 is repealed.

24 Section 3. REPEAL. -- That version of Section 22-8-9 NMSA  
25 1978 (being Laws 1967, Chapter 16, Section 63, as amended) that

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1 is to become effective July 1, 1996 pursuant to Laws 1994,  
2 Chapter 68, Section 1, as amended by Laws 1995, Chapter 151,  
3 Section 1, is repealed.
