"63-9F-11. IMPOSITION OF SURCHARGE. --

A telecommunications relay service surcharge of A. thirty-three one hundredths of one percent is imposed on the gross amount paid by customers for intrastate telephone services provided in this state. The surcharge shall be included on the monthly bill of each customer of a local exchange company or other telecommunications company providing intrastate telephone services and paid at the time of payment of the monthly bill. Receipts from selling a service to any other telecommunications company or provider for resale shall not be subject to the surcharge. The customer shall be liable for the payment of this surcharge to the local exchange company or other telecommunications company providing intrastate telephone services to the customer.

B. Every telecommunications company [except a company contributing to the interstate relay service] providing intrastate telephone services shall be responsible for assessing, collecting and remitting the telecommunications relay service surcharge to the taxation and revenue department. The amount of the telecommunications relay service surcharge collected by a telecommunications company shall be remitted monthly to the taxation and revenue department, on or before the twenty-fifth of the month following collection, which shall administer and enforce the collection of the surcharge pursuant to the provisions of the Tax Administration Act.

C. The taxation and revenue department shall remit
to the telecommunications access fund the amount of the
telecommunications relay service surcharge collected less any
amount deducted pursuant to the provisions of Subsection D of
this section. Transfer of the net receipts from the surcharge
to the telecommunications access fund shall be made within the
month following the month in which the surcharge is collected.

- The taxation and revenue department may deduct an amount not to exceed three percent of the telecommunications relay service surcharge collected as a charge for the administrative costs of collection, which amount shall be remitted to the state treasurer for deposit in the general fund each month.
- E. The general services department shall report to the revenue stabilization and tax policy committee annually by September 30 the following information with respect to the prior fiscal year:
- (1) the amount and source of revenue received by the telecommunications access fund;
- (2) the amount and category of expenditures from the fund; and
- (3) the balance of the fund on that June 30." Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 1996.
