AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO CONTINUE
DEVELOPMENT OF A CRASH OUTCOME DATA EVALUATION SYSTEM; DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) is
appropriated from the general fund to the department of health for expenditure in fiscal year
1997 by the division of epidemiology, planning and evaluation to continue development of a
crash outcome data evaluation system for the purpose of both injury treatment and accident
prevention. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year
1997 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that
this act take effect immediately.
