AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION PROGRAM FOR
AT-RISK PARENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Five hundred twenty thousand
dollars (\$520,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
vocational education division of the state department of public
education for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of
expanding a high school education program for at-risk teenage
parents to additional sites located statewide. Funding shall be
used to hire additional personnel to establish and teach at the
new sites and to provide child-care services at the new sites.
Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
