AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE TEACHER TRAINING IN SOFTWARE AND COMPUTER EQUIPMENT USE AND TO PURCHASE SOFTWARE AND TECHNOLOGICAL EQUIPMENT FOR COMPUTER LAB NEEDS AT DEL NORTE HIGH SCHOOL IN THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE LOCATED IN BERNALILLO COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred sixty-three thousand dollars (\$163,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purpose of providing teacher training in software and computer equipment use and to purchase software and technological equipment for special computer lab needs at Del Norte high school in the city of Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county. Any unexpended or

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Seventy-six thousand four hundred dollars (\$76,400) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purpose of funding the Albuquerque city center schools technology program to provide technology-based instruction and professional development at Montezuma elementary school located in Bernalillo county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purpose of funding the technology program

2 development at Del Norte high school located in Bernalillo  
3 county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the
