AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO FUND VARIOUS SENIOR CITIZEN PROGRAMS  
THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Four million five hundred thirty-two thousand  
nine hundred fifty-seven dollars (\$4,532,957) is appropriated  
from the general fund to the state agency on aging for  
expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the following purposes and  
in the following amounts:

- (1) three million nine hundred five thousand  
two hundred sixteen dollars (\$3,905,216) to the six area  
agencies on aging for senior services, including case  
management, respite care, adult daycare, congregate meals, home-  
delivered meals, transportation and in-home services;

(2) four hundred forty-two thousand fifty-one dollars (\$442,051) to provide increased volunteer positions for the foster grandparent, senior companion and RSVP programs; and

(3) one hundred eighty-five thousand six hundred ninety dollars (\$185,690) for increased respite care services, information and assistance and consultation and education services for individuals with Alzheimer's disease or related disorders and their families or caregivers.

B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
