AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO CONTINUE A PROGRAM ENCOURAGING
ADOLESCENTS TO PURSUE A COLLEGE EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --Two hundred fifty thousand
dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure
in fiscal year 1997 to continue a program that encourages
adolescents to prepare for college by guaranteeing admission to
the university of New Mexico if certain grade point average
criteria are met. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the
general fund.
