AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO FOR THE
CHARLIE MORRISEY RESEARCH HALL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred thousand dollars
(\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of
regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in
fiscal year 1997 by the African-American studies department to
purchase history books, rare manuscripts and other documents by
and about African-Americans in New Mexico, including rare
photographs, films, slides, videotapes and artifacts; to
purchase computers and other equipment to catalog and use the
collection; and to provide stipends for two research assistants
at the Charlie Morrissey research hall. Any unexpended or
unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997
