BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 by the African-American studies department to purchase history books, rare manuscripts and other documents by and about African-Americans in New Mexico, including rare photographs, films, slides, videotapes and artifacts; to purchase computers and other equipment to catalog and use the collection; and to provide stipends for two research assistants at the Charlie Morrisey research hall. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997

shall revert to the general fund. - 2 -
