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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
17	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
18	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
19	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding
20	Act in an amount not exceeding five hundred eighty-three
21	thousand five hundred fifty-nine dollars (\$583,559) when the
22	state department of public education certifies the need for the
23	issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall
24	schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most
25	expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the

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1 board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to 2 contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance 3 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply 4 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 5 The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the 6 state department of public education in the following amounts 7 for the following purposes: 8 9 (1)four hundred sixty-one thousand eight 10 hundred thirty-seven dollars (\$461,837) to design, construct and 11 equip a shower and locker room facility and to purchase and 12 install bleachers in the gymnasium in the Corona public schools 13 in Lincoln county; 14 twenty-five thousand seven hundred twenty-(2)two dollars (\$25,722) to purchase an activity car for the Corona 15 16 public schools in Lincoln county; 17 five thousand dollars (\$5,000) to purchase (3) 18 and install a satellite for the Corona public schools in Lincoln 19 county; and (4) ninety-one thousand dollars (\$91,000) to 20 purchase and install educational technology for the Capitan 21 municipal schools in Lincoln county. 22 23 If the state department of public education has B. not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end 24 25 of fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided in this section . 109635. 1 - 2 -

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		1	shall be void. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
		2	from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to
		3	Subsection A of this section at the end of fiscal year 1999
		4	shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

		6	peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
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
