AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE NEW MEXICO FINANCE AUTHORITY FOR
DEVELOPMENT OF A PLAN FOR A GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the New Mexico finance authority for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of developing or contracting for the development of a plan for a geographic information system to serve all New Mexico. In developing the plan, the authority shall at a minimum:

(1) review the status of current base maps and geographic information data accessible in counties throughout New Mexico and identify the desirable features of a fully developed geographic information system for all New Mexico counties;

(2) identify counties where the need for a geographic information system is greatest;

(3) identify interested private and public parties and information resources and work with those private and public parties and information resources to develop

2 (4) determine implementation costs and possible funding sources;
3 (5) review other geographic information systems around the state,
4 including those maintained by the state land office, federal laboratories and title companies;

6 (6) complete the plan and submit it to the New Mexico finance
7 authority oversight committee by November 1, 1996.

8 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal
9 year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
