AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR PROJECTS IN TORRANCE COUNTY;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Six hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$680,000) is appropriated from the general fund in the following amounts to the following agencies for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the following purposes:

(1) two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to the state department of public education to acquire and install educational technology for the Moriarty public schools in Torrance county;

(2) eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) to the local government division of the department of finance and

1 administration to acquire new vehicles for the Torrance county
2 sheriff's department; and

3 (3) three hundred fifty thousand dollars
4 (\$350,000) to the office of the state engineer to purchase five
5 hundred thirteen acre-feet of water rights for the city of
6 Moriarty in Torrance county.

7 B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
8 at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.

9 Section 2. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public
