AN ACT

RELATING TO LEGISLATIVE AGENCY BUDGETS; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS
FOR ADDITIONAL STAFF FOR THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL SERVICE AND FOR
AN ENHANCED SECURITY SYSTEM FOR THE STATE CAPITOL; DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --Two hundred fifty thousand
dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
legislative council service for expenditure in fiscal years 1996
and 1997 for the purpose of hiring additional professional and
clerical staff to meet the demands imposed as a result of a
substantial increase in bill-draft requests. Any unexpended or
unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997
shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. APPROPRIATION. --Two hundred thousand dollars

1 (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
2 legislative maintenance department for expenditure in fiscal
3 year 1997 for the purpose of installing an enhanced security
4 system in the underground parking garage of the state capitol.
5 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
6 fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.

7 Section 3. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public
8 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
