AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE A HYDROLOGIC ANALYSIS OF THE VILLAGE OF PLACITAS TO DETERMINE GROUND WATER AVAILABILITY, FLOW AND CHEMISTRY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for a hydrologic analysis of the village of Placitas to determine ground water availability, flow and chemistry. The local government division of the department of finance and administration shall seek the advice of and use any pertinent reports of the office of the state engineer, the interstate stream commission, the water quality control commission and the

1 department of environment relevant to the hydrologic analysis.
2 This appropriation is contingent on the board of county
3 commissioners of Sandoval county providing matching funds of at
4 least ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) from sources other than the
5 state. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the
6 end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
