AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIODS;
EXPANDING PURPOSES; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. GENERAL FUND--GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT--
EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIOD--APPROPRIATION. --Notwithstanding
the provisions of Paragraph (3) of Subsection A of Section 71 of
Chapter 148 of Laws 1994, the period of time in which the
following appropriations to the property control division of the
general services department made in Laws 1993, Chapter 366 may
be expended shall be extended through fiscal year 1998:

A. from the general fund to bring state buildings
into compliance with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act
of 1990 pursuant to Subsection M of Section 3; and

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1 B. from the general fund operating reserve to
2 construct and equip a state library, records and archives
3 building pursuant to Subsection 0 of Section 4.

4 Section 2. GENERAL FUND--GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT--
5 EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIOD--EXPANSION OF PURPOSE--
6 APPROPRIATION. --Notwithstanding the provisions of Subparagraph
7 (a) of Paragraph (3) of Subsection A of Section 71 of Chapter
8 148 of Laws 1994, the appropriation from the general fund to the
9 property control division of the general services department
10 made in Subsection N of Section 3 of Chapter 366 of Laws 1993
11 for a study committee and to plan for a comprehensive state
12 library, records and archives building is reauthorized and the
13 balance is appropriated for construction of the state library,
14 records and archives building. Any unexpended or unencumbered
15 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to
16 the general fund.

17 Section 3. GENERAL FUND--DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY--
18 EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIOD--APPROPRIATION. --Notwithstanding
19 the provisions of Paragraph (9) of Subsection A of Section 71 of
20 Chapter 148 of Laws 1994, the period of time in which the
21 appropriation from the general fund to the department of public
22 safety for a training building at the department training
23 facility in Santa Fe county made in Subsection JJ of Section 4
24 of Chapter 366 of Laws 1993 may be expended shall be extended
25 through fiscal year 1997.

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1 Section 4. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--GENERAL SERVICES
2 DEPARTMENT--EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIOD--APPROPRIATION.--The
3 period of time in which the following appropriations from
4 severance tax bond proceeds to the property control division of
5 the general services department made in Laws 1993, Chapter 367,
6 Section 14 may be expended shall be extended through fiscal year
7 1997:

8 A. to acquire a building and land for a primary
9 health care facility located in Chaves county pursuant to
10 Subsection C;

11 B. to plan, design and construct a secure treatment
12 cottage at the Las Vegas medical center located in San Miguel
13 county pursuant to Subsection D;

14 C. to plan and design a facility to house the
15 administration and provide a controlled visitor center at the
16 New Mexico boys' school located in Colfax county pursuant to
17 Subsection E;

18 D. to plan and design a multipurpose recreation
19 center at the Sequoyah treatment center located in Bernalillo
20 county pursuant to Subsection F;

21 E. to remove and replace the north and south roofs
22 at the penitentiary of New Mexico located in Santa Fe county
23 pursuant to Subsection K;

24 F. to repair the education building at the New
25 Mexico boys' school at Springer located in Colfax county

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1 pursuant to Subsection L;

2 G. to replace the steam condensation lines in
3 building 300 of the New Mexico rehabilitation center located in
4 Chaves county pursuant to Subsection M;

5 H. to renovate the Los Lunas medical center located
6 in Valencia county in order to comply with the Americans with
7 Disabilities Act of 1990 pursuant to Subsection P;

8 I. to renovate the electrical system of building 300
9 of the New Mexico rehabilitation center located in Chaves county
10 pursuant to Subsection Q;

11 J. to construct and provide access to a dining and
12 activities area at the New Mexico veterans' center located in
13 Sierra county pursuant to Subsection R;

14 K. to remodel the national guard complex on
15 Cerrillos road located in Santa Fe county for moving and other
16 expenses of any state agency that will occupy space in this
17 complex pursuant to Subsection X;

18 L. to complete phase one of the renovation of the
19 Bataan memorial building located in Santa Fe county pursuant to
20 Subsection Y; and

21 M. for planning, designing and constructing a state
22 police headquarters in Hobbs located in Lea county pursuant to
23 Subsection Z.

24 Section 5. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--GENERAL SERVICES
25 DEPARTMENT--EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIOD--CHANGE IN PURPOSE--

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1 APPROPRIATION. -- Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection D
2 of Section 1 of Chapter 367 of Laws 1993, the balance of the
3 proceeds from the sale of severance tax bonds appropriated to
4 the property control division of the general services
5 department, pursuant to Subsection S of Section 14 of Chapter
6 367 of Laws 1993, to remodel Sierra cottage at Fort Stanton
7 hospital shall not be expended for its original purpose but is
8 reauthorized and appropriated to the property control division
9 of the general services department to repair and renovate
10 buildings at Fort Stanton hospital located in Lincoln county.
11 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
12 fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

13 Section 6. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--GENERAL SERVICES

14 DEPARTMENT--CHANGE OF PURPOSE. -- Notwithstanding the provisions
15 of Subsection H of Section 13 of Chapter 148 of Laws 1994, the
16 balance of the proceeds from the sale of severance tax bonds
17 appropriated to the property control division of the general
18 services department to remodel and make other needed
19 modifications and improvements to convert the Socorro cottage at
20 Fort Stanton hospital to a long-term care nursing facility shall
21 not be expended for its original purpose but is reauthorized and
22 appropriated to the property control division of the general
23 services department to repair and renovate buildings at Fort
24 Stanton hospital located in Lincoln county.

25 Section 7. PROCEEDS OF SALE OF LAND--GENERAL SERVICES

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1 DEPARTMENT-- EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIOD-- APPROPRIATION. --
2 Notwithstanding the provisions of Laws 1994, Chapter 148,
3 Section 41, the period of time in which the proceeds from the
4 sale by the property control division of the general services
5 department of the property that is located at the southeast
6 corner of St. Michael's drive at St. Francis drive in the city
7 of Santa Fe and that was purchased with money appropriated from
8 the capital projects fund to the capital program fund pursuant
9 to Paragraph (12) of Subsection B of Section 2 of Chapter 315 of
10 Laws 1989 for the purpose of constructing and equipping the
11 state library, archives and records center to be located in
12 Santa Fe county may be expended shall be extended through fiscal
13 year 1998.

14 Section 8. GENERAL FUND-- CAPITAL PROGRAM FUND-- EXTENDING
15 EXPENDITURE PERIOD-- APPROPRIATION. --Notwithstanding the
16 provisions of Subsection A of Section 43 of Chapter 148 of Laws
17 1994, the period of time in which the appropriations from the
18 general fund to the capital program fund made in Laws 1994,
19 Chapter 148, Section 43 may be expended shall be extended
20 through fiscal year 1997:

21 A. to continue the construction, renovation and
22 repair of state buildings throughout the state to comply with
23 the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 pursuant to
24 Subsection C;

25 B. for the planning, design and engineering of phase

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1 one of the renovation of Turquoise lodge pursuant to Subsection
2 D; and

3 C. to design, plan, construct, equip and furnish an
4 addition to the Albuquerque office of the New Mexico commission
5 for the blind pursuant to Subsection E.

6 Section 9. GENERAL FUND--GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT--
7 EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIOD-- APPROPRIATION. --Notwithstanding
8 the provisions of Subsection B of Section 52 of Chapter 148 of
9 Laws 1994, the period of time in which the appropriation from
10 the general fund to the general services department to plan,
11 design, construct, furnish or equip a secure forensic treatment
12 facility at the Las Vegas medical center located in San Miguel
13 county may be expended shall be extended through fiscal year
14 1997.

15 Section 10. EMPLOYMENT SECURITY DEPARTMENT FUND-- EXTENDING
16 EXPENDITURE PERIOD-- APPROPRIATIONS. --Notwithstanding the
17 provisions of Subsection A of Section 54 of Chapter 148 of Laws
18 1994, the period of time in which the following appropriations
19 from the employment security department fund to the capital
20 program fund in Laws 1994, Chapter 148, Section 54 may be
21 expended shall be extended through fiscal year 1997:

22 A. to make certain improvements to the Alamogordo
23 office of the labor department located in Otero county in order
24 to comply with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of
25 1990 pursuant to Paragraph (1);

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1 B. to make certain improvements to the Albuquerque
2 office of the labor department located in Bernalillo county in
3 order to comply with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act
4 of 1990 pursuant to Paragraph (2);

5 C. to modify or make certain improvements to the
6 Artesia office of the labor department located in Eddy county,
7 including modifications that will comply with the federal
8 Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, pursuant to Paragraph
9 (3);

10 D. to modify or make certain improvements to the
11 Farmington office of the labor department located in San Juan
12 county, including modifications that will comply with the
13 federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, pursuant to
14 Paragraph (5);

15 E. to modify or make certain improvements to the Las
16 Cruces office of the labor department located in Dona Ana
17 county, including modifications that will comply with the
18 federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, pursuant to
19 Paragraph (7);

20 F. to modify or make certain improvements to the Las
21 Vegas office of the labor department located in San Miguel
22 county, including modifications that will comply with the
23 federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, pursuant to
24 Paragraph (8);

25 G. to modify or make certain improvements to the

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1 Santa Fe office of the labor department located in Santa Fe
2 county, including modifications that will comply with the
3 federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, pursuant to
4 Paragraph (9);

5 H. to modify, renovate, expand or make certain
6 improvements to the Silver City office of the labor department
7 located in Grant county, including modifications that will
8 comply with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990,
9 pursuant to Paragraph (10); and

10 I. to modify or make certain improvements to the
11 Tiwa building of the labor department located in Bernalillo
12 count in order to comply with the federal Americans with
13 Disabilities Act of 1990 pursuant to Paragraph (11).

14 Section 11. EMPLOYMENT SECURITY DEPARTMENT FUND-- EXTENDING
15 EXPENDITURE PERIOD-- APPROPRIATION. --Notwithstanding the
16 provisions of Laws 1995, Chapter 41, Sections 1 and 2, the
17 period of time in which the appropriations from the employment
18 security department fund to the property control division of the
19 general services department may be expended shall be extended
20 through fiscal year 1997:

21 A. for acquisition of, remodeling or renovating an
22 existing building for an office for the labor department in the
23 Deming area in Luna county pursuant to Section 1; and

24 B. for the purpose of acquiring, remodeling and
25 renovating an existing building for an office for the labor

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1 department in the Deming area in Luna county pursuant to Section
2 2.

3 Section 12. GENERAL FUND--GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT--
4 ENCUMBERED BALANCE-- APPROPRIATION. --The encumbered balance from
5 the general fund appropriation pursuant to Subsection G of
6 Section 3 of Chapter 147 of Laws 1994 is reauthorized and
7 appropriated to the general services department to purchase
8 vehicles for state agencies and provide for required alternative
9 fuels conversion.

10 Section 13. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public
11 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
