dollars (\$8,000,000) when the state highway and transportation department certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state highway and transportation department for expenditure in Bernalillo county in the following amounts for the following purposes:

(1) five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for improvements to the north valley storm drain system and roads in the north valley area of Albuquerque; and

(2) three million dollars (\$3,000,000) for site preparation, construction, installation, testing and maintenance of a drainage water pump station at the northeast corner of Rio Grande boulevard and Montano road.
