AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES: AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR VARIOUS PROJECTS OF THE LOS LUNAS SCHOOL DISTRICT IN VALENCIA COUNTY: MAKING AN APPROPRIATION: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--PURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED--Section 1. APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS. --

The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding five hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$580,000) when the state department of public education certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible

upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state department of public education in the following amounts for the following purposes:

- (1) three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to plan, design or construct a five-classroom addition to the Katherine Gallegos school;
- (2) two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to renovate and remodel the Peralta school main building; and
- (3) thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) to upgrade the electrical system at the Bosque Farms school.
- B. If the state department of education has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided in this section shall be void. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Subsection A of this section at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
