AN ACT

FOR THE LEGISLATIVE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT FOR AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN RECIPIENT RELOCATION AND COMMUNICATION ASSISTANCE AND TO THE CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT FOR EXPANDED CHILD-CARE SERVICES TO ASSIST LOW-INCOME FAMILIES TO ACHIEVE INDEPENDENCE FROM PUBLIC ASSISTANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS. --

The following amounts are appropriated to the following agencies for the following purposes for expenditure in fiscal year 1997:

three hundred fifty thousand dollars **(1)** (\$350,000) from the general fund to the children, youth and families department to expand the project forward program childcare services to areas of the state currently without such

child-care services;

- **(2)** one million dollars (\$1,000,000) from the general fund to the children, youth and families department to extend transitional child-care coverage an additional twelve months to families that leave the aid to families with dependent children program because of increased earnings and to increase the availability of child care to income-eligible parents;
- one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) from the general fund to the human services department for relocation assistance for parents who receive assistance from the aid to families with dependent children program; and
- thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) from the general fund to the human services department for the purpose of paying for telephone service for parents who receive assistance from the aid to families with dependent children program.
- Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining В. at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
