17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding twenty-five thousand
21	dollars (\$25,000) when the state highway and transportation
22	department certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds.
23	The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale
24	of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner
25	possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been

1 developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 2 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 3 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 4 5 The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are amended. 6 appropriated to the state highway and transportation department for the purpose of planning a segment of the Salt Missions 7 scenic byway located in Torrance county. Any unexpended or 8 9 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 10 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the state highway and transportation department has not certified the need 11 12 for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, 13 the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
