AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO ENABLE NEW MEXICO STATE UNIVERSITY TO MEET OPERATIONAL AND EQUIPMENT COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH GENDER EQUITY REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION IN INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred eighty-five thousand dollars (\$185,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico state university for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of paying operational and equipment costs necessary to meet gender equity requirements for intercollegiate athletics imposed by Title IX. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
