BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Twenty-five thousand dollars (25,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the energy, minerals and natural resources department for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of landscaping, including dugout construction, and purchase and installation of recreation equipment, including backstops and football and soccer goal posts and fencing, for the multipurpose recreation field in the community of Galisteo in Santa Fe county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
