17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one hundred eighty-
21	seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$187,500) when the local
22	government division of the department of finance and
23	administration certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds.
24	The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale
25	of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner

1 possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the 2 project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 3 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 4 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 5 6 amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are 7 appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for the purpose of planning, 8 9 designing or constructing a warehouse for voting machines located in Torrance county. 10 Any unexpended or unencumbered 11 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to 12 the severance tax bonding fund. If the local government 13 division of the department of finance and administration has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of 14 15 fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided in this section 16 shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
