18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
20	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
21	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one hundred thirty
22	thousand dollars (\$130,000) when the state agency on aging
23	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
24	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the
25	bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible

1 upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 2 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 3 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 4 5 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 6 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state agency on aging for the purpose of completing 7 construction, including archaeological site mitigation, of a 8 9 senior citizen center at San Miguel del Vado located in San 10 Miguel county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining 11 at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax 12 bonding fund. If the state agency on aging has not certified 13 the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 14 1998, the authorization provided in this section shall be void. Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public 15 16 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately. 17 - 2 -18 19
