18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
20	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
21	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding sixty thousand
22	dollars (\$60,000) when the board of regents of the university of
23	New Mexico certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds.
24	The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale
25	of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner

1 possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the 2 project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 3 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 4 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 5 6 amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the board of regents of the university of New 7 Mexico for the purpose of planning, designing and installing 8 9 distance learning capabilities at the Gallup branch of the 10 university of New Mexico located in McKinley county. Any 11 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining six months after 12 completion of the project shall revert to the severance tax 13 If the board of regents of the university of New bonding fund. 14 Mexico has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in 15 16 this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
