AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR HEADSTART PROGRAMS IN MCKINLEY COUNTY; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--PURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED--
APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--

A. The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding two hundred thirty thousand two hundred sixty-four dollars (\$230,264) when the New Mexico office of Indian affairs certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated

1 to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs in the following amounts for the following purposes:

2 (1) fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for designing, constructing,
3 equipping and furnishing the Coyote Canyon headstart program located in McKinley county;

4 (2) one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the construction
5 of an addition to and the renovation of the Red Lake chapter headstart program in McKinley
6 county; and

7 (3) thirty thousand two hundred sixty-four dollars (\$30,264) for the
8 repair of and construction to the Church Rock Unit II preschool, a headstart program in
9 McKinley county.
10

11 B. If the New Mexico office of Indian affairs has not certified the need for the
12 issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided in this section
13 shall be void. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of
14 severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Subsection A of this section at the end of fiscal year
15 1999 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

16 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that
17 this act take effect immediately.
