#### Abstract

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF CERTAIN EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE CITY OF RIO RANCHO IN DEALING WITH THE NEW MEXICO PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION.


## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Three hundred fifty-one thousand one hundred fiftythree dollars $(\$ 351,153)$ is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of reimbursing the city of Rio Rancho for litigation and other expenses incurred as a result of legal and regulatory issues raised by the New Mexico public utility commission in connection with acquisition of a water utility. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
