AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING BALANCES AND
CHANGING PURPOSES OF CAPITAL PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; MAKING
APPROPRIATIONS FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS IN SENATE DISTRICT 30 IN
CIBOLA COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
ADMINISTRATION--CHANGES IN PURPOSE--EXTENDING EXPENDITURE
PERIOD--APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. The balance of the proceeds from severance tax
bonds appropriated to the local government division of the
department of finance and administration to design, construct
and equip an addition to the Cibola general hospital in Grants
in Cibola county pursuant to Subsection YYY of Section 7 of
Chapter 367 of Laws 1993 shall not be expended for that purpose

1 but is reauthorized and appropriated for the purpose of
2 constructing, equipping and furnishing a multipurpose
3 recreational facility in the city of Grants located in Cibola
4 county. The period of time for expenditure of the appropriation
5 is extended through fiscal year 1998. Any unexpended or
6 unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998
7 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

8 B. The balance of the proceeds from severance tax
9 bonds appropriated to the local government division of the
10 department of finance and administration to plan and design the
11 Cibola general hospital in Cibola county pursuant to Subsection
12 DDDDD of Section 9 of Chapter 148 of Laws 1994 shall not be
13 expended for that purpose but is reauthorized and appropriated
14 to construct, equip or furnish a multipurpose recreational
15 facility in the city of Grants located in Cibola county. The
16 period of term for expenditure of the appropriation is extended
17 through fiscal year 1998. Any unexpended or unencumbered
18 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to
19 the severance tax bonding fund.

20 Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--CHANGE OF AGENCY--CHANGE
21 IN PURPOSE--APPROPRIATION.--The balance of the proceeds from
22 severance tax bonds appropriated to the office of cultural
23 affairs for museum exhibits or audio-visual materials for El
24 Malpais national monument in Cibola county pursuant to
25 Subsection H of Section 4 of Chapter 367 of Laws 1993 and as

1 reauthorized and changed pursuant to Laws 1995, Chapter 218,
2 Section 43 shall not be expended for that purpose but is
3 reauthorized and appropriated to the local government division
4 of the department of finance and administration to construct,
5 equip or furnish a multipurpose recreational facility in the
6 city of Grants in Cibola county. Any unexpended or unencumbered
7 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to
8 the severance tax bonding fund.

9 Section 3. GENERAL FUND--CHANGE OF AGENCY--CHANGE IN
10 PURPOSE-- APPROPRIATION. --The balance of the appropriation from
11 the general fund to the state highway and transportation
12 department for improvements to and replacement of a water line
13 at Ralph Card road in the village of Milan in Cibola county
14 pursuant to Subsection T of Section 27 of Chapter 222 of Laws
15 1995 shall not be expended for that purpose but is reauthorized
16 and appropriated to the department of environment to repair and
17 renovate the Golden Acres well in the village of Milan in Cibola
18 county.

19 Section 4. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public
20 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
