AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLANNING, CONDUCTING AND EVALUATING A COMMUNITY POLICING PROGRAM FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS DURING TRAINING AT THE NEW MEXICO LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of public safety for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of planning, conducting and evaluating a community policing program for law enforcement officers during training at the New Mexico law enforcement academy. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
