AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS TO PLAN, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT A REGIONAL JUVENILE DETENTION CENTER TO HOUSE PRE-ADJUDICATED JUVENILES FOR LUNA, HIDALGO AND OTHER COUNTIES; MAKING AN APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--PURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED--

APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding six hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$625,000) when the children, youth and families department certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated

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1 to the children, youth and families department for the purpose of planning, designing and
2 constructing a regional juvenile detention center to house pre-adjudicated juveniles for Luna,
3 Hidalgo and other counties as needed and at reasonable rates. Luna county will pay the costs of
4 operation and construction costs above six hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$625,000).
5 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert
6 to the severance tax bonding fund. If the children, youth and families department has not
7 certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization
8 provided in this section shall be void.

10 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that
11 this act take effect immediately.
