AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO UPGRADE AN EDUCATIONAL COMPUTER SYSTEM

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of upgrading an educational computer system for a private nonprofit boarding school serving primarily Native American and Hispanic children in grades seven through twelve. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
