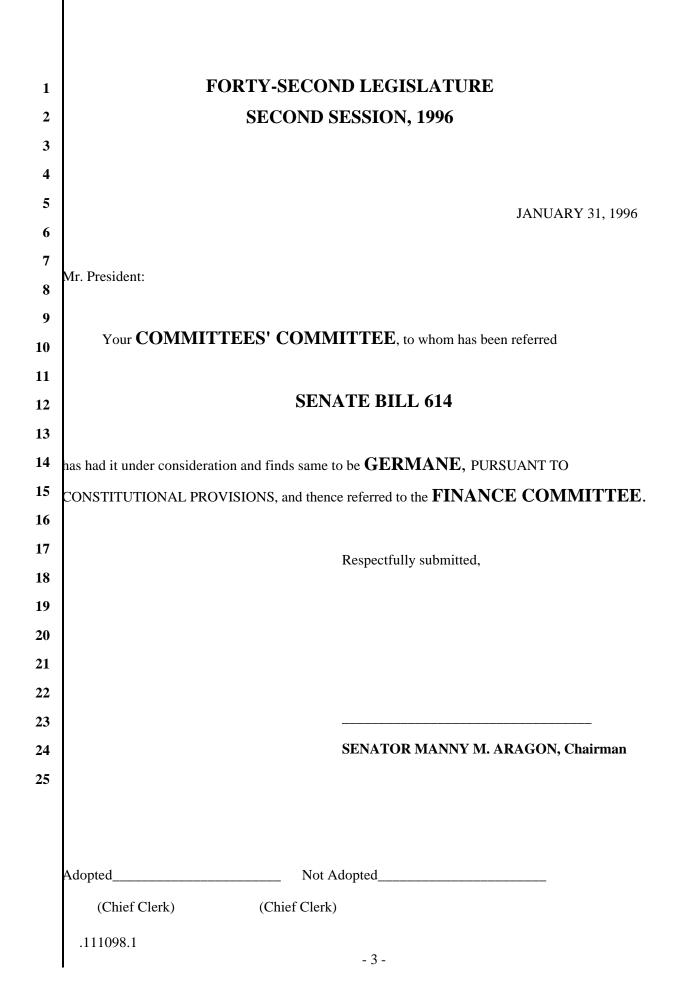

11	RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF
12	SEVERANCE TAX BONDS TO PURCHASE MATERIALS, EQUIPMENT AND
13	ACQUISITIONS FOR THE NAVAJO COMMUNITY COLLEGE LIBRARY ON THE
14	CROWNPOINT CAMPUS LOCATED IN MCKINLEY COUNTY; MAKING AN
15	APPROPRIATION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue and sell severance
20	tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one
21	hundred eight thousand dollars (\$108,000) when the New Mexico office of Indian affairs
22 23	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the
23 24	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a
25	finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and
	that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance
	shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of
	1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the New

1	Mexico office of Indian affairs for the purpose of purchasing materials, equipment and
2	acquisitions for the Navajo community college library on the Crownpoint campus located in
3	McKinley county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal
4	year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the New Mexico office of Indian
5	affairs has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998,
6	the authorization provided in this section shall be void.
7	Section 2. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that
8 9	this act take effect immediately.
