AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF
EDUCATIONAL COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY FOR THE P.R. LEYVA JUNIOR HIGH
SCHOOL IN EDDY COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purpose of purchasing and installing educational computer technology at the P.R. Leyva junior high school in the Carlsbad municipal school district in Eddy county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
